

TERRARIUM CARE:

OPEN CONTAINERS

WE LOVE: the Artisan, Mixed Materials & Hanging Terrariums

- Ideal plants: succulents, aloe, hens and chicks, cacti, and air plants.
- Water thoroughly when soil dries out.
- Use dried materials in open systems, such as sticks, pinecones, preserved mosses and lichens.

CLOSED CONTAINERS

WE LOVE: Glass Cloches and the Milk Jug container with Lid

- Ideal plants: tropicals, baby ferns, aechmea, neoregelia, and cryptanthus.
- Do not add water at time of planting.
 A closed system creates its own ecosystem

PLANT CARE TIPS & TRICKS:



Tillandsia / Air Plants

- Best in open containers.
- Prefer bright light (direct or indirect).
- Water by misting frequently OR immerse in water when especially dry.
- Temporarily remove air plants from terrarium to water.



Succulents

- Best in open containers.
- Prefer bright light (direct or indirect).
- Water thoroughly when soil dries out completely.



Tropical Plants

- Best in closed containers.
- Prefer medium to bright light (indirect).
- Water thoroughly when soil is dry (but not dried out).
- Make sure to water thoroughly, but do not oversaturate.



Cacti

- Best in open containers.
- Prefer bright, direct light.
- Water thoroughly when soil has been dry for a period of time.
