Gang recommends subbing the hyacinth with a pastel dahlia. Design time: 20-30 minutes. Wholesale costs: \$63. Suggested retail price: \$275.

An example of Tropical Nouveau, this design blends romantic 'Free Spirit' roses with more exoticlooking blooms, such as Monstera leaves, Robellini palms and a Phalaenopsis orchid. "We love this style for a corporate lobby or event," Gang said. "We also have a lot of clients with sleek and modern homes," she added. "It would be perfect for them." Design time: 20 minutes. Wholesale costs: \$88. Suggested retail price: \$380.
