## **SAF Orlando 2021 Safety Protocols**

As SAF prepares to welcome you in September, attendee safety is a top priority. We are committed to creating an environment where all attendees are comfortable. As a result, SAF is proactively establishing our own safety protocols for the event.

## What We're Doing

- The entire SAF staff team is vaccinated and will be wearing masks indoors throughout the event.
- Employees of the Loews Royal Pacific Resort and Universal Aventura hotels will also be wearing masks at all times indoors.
- The hotel remains committed to maintaining the highest cleanliness and sanitization standards, and hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the hotel (including in the lobby area, elevator waiting areas, at the front desk, SAF's registration desk, in meeting spaces, bathrooms, restaurants, etc.)
- In the convention space, rooms will be designed to accommodate social distancing during food functions and educational sessions.

## What We're Asking You to Do

- For everyone's safety, SAF encourages convention attendees to be vaccinated prior to arrival.
- In accordance with CDC guidelines, SAF strongly encourages all attendees to wear masks — regardless of vaccination status — while inside convention spaces in the hotel.
- SAF will have masks available for all attendees.
- We will also make it easy for you to immediately recognize everyone's comfort level
  with social distancing, and convey your own, by providing color-coded stickers you
  can put on your badge, if you wish. Green means "I'm fine with hugs"; yellow means
  "I am fine with fist bumps and handshakes"; and red means "I prefer a wave." If you
  don't want to use the sticker for your name badge, that's fine too.

We are committed to safely accommodating all participants, and we know that everyone will come together and play their part to make SAF Orlando 2021 a safe and enjoyable event. Given that local conditions and related guidance are constantly evolving, SAF will continue to monitor the situation and will update attendees on any changes in CDC policy or SAF's safety protocols via email and on our website.
