Conceived as an outdoor laboratory for gardening in harmony with natural ecosystems, the Garden opened in the fall of 2006.

Transportation from Florida house to Ritz-Carlton Pentagon City

- **Uber-** easily available around Florida House- ride is about 20-25 minutes (depending on traffic)
- **Metro (about 40-45 minutes including walk)**
 - Walk .5 miles from Florida house to Capitol South Station > take [blue line towards Franconia-Springfield](#) 12 stops to Pentagon City station > Exit metro station via west side of Hayes St. between Army-Navy Dr. and 15th St. to walk to hotel.
