GoogleLM serves as your team's helpful librarian, giving instant access to SOPs, policies, and how-to guides so staff can find answers fast and stay on track.



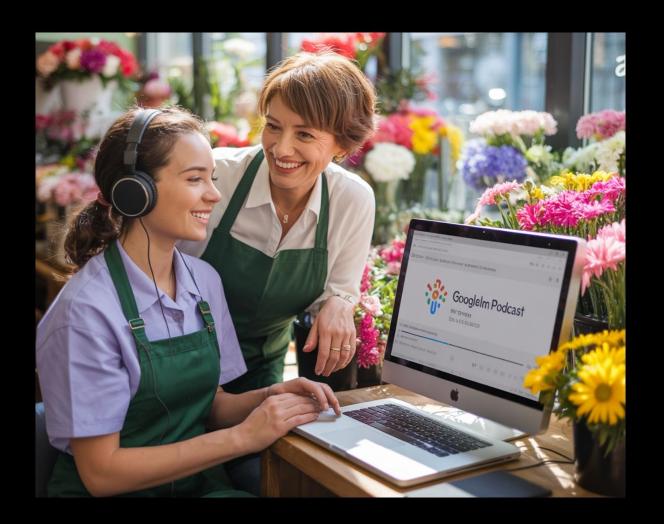
Training on Demand

Knowledge Sources for Al



Portable Document Format (PDF) files are commonly used as knowledge sources for AI systems, as they can contain structured and unstructured data, including text, images, and other multimedia elements.



Text Documents

Plain text files, such as .txt files, can provide valuable textual information for Al algorithms to analyze and learn from.

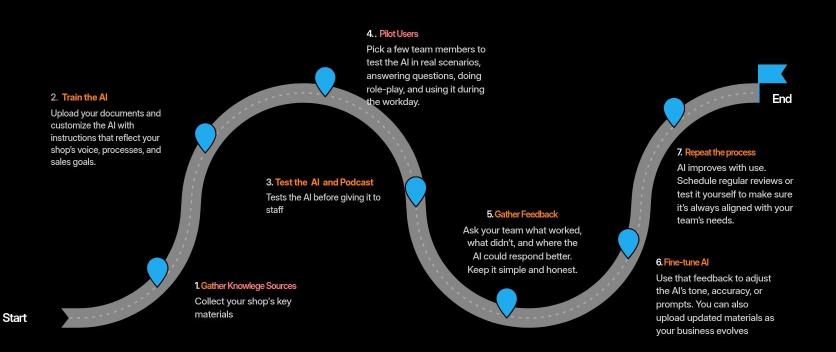


Word Documents

Microsoft Word documents (.doc or .docx) are widely used to store written content, which can be leveraged as knowledge sources for Al models.

By utilizing a variety of document formats, including PDF, text, and Word documents, Al systems can access a diverse range of knowledge sources to enhance their learning and decision-making capabilities.

Custom GPT Milestones



Limitations of CustomGPT & GoogleLM

Hallucinations

Al can confidently generate answers that sound correct but aren't. It's important to verify information, especially for pricing, policies, or care tips.

Limited Industry Context

If the Al isn't trained on your shop's materials, it may give generic responses that don't match your way of doing things.

Outdated Information

Al doesn't know what happened yesterday. Unless updated regularly with your own documents, it might reference old trends or processes.

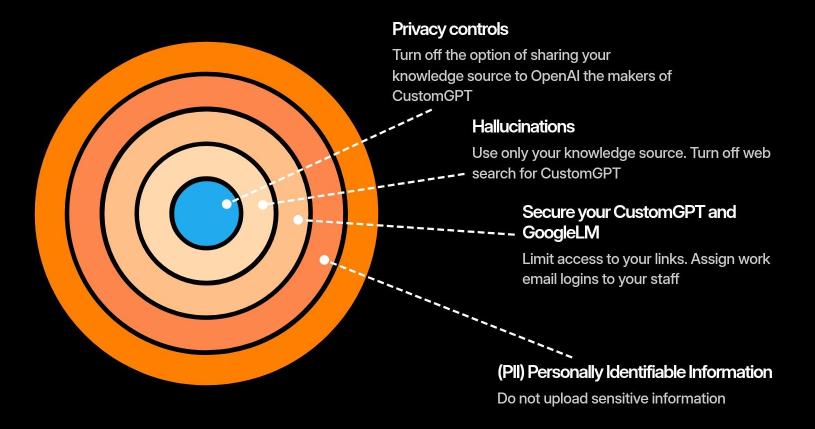
No Emotional Intelligence

Al can't read the room. It may miss tone, urgency, or subtle cues that a human would pick up during customer interactions.

Requires Regular Maintenance

For best results, you need to keep the Al trained and refreshed with your latest SOPs, promos, and feedback—just like you would a real team member.
